



Comprehensive School Improvement Plan 2015 to 2020

**Goal 1: The Ritenour School District will demonstrate improvement in the performance of every student to meet or exceed the state standard or demonstrate required improvement and enable every student to meet their personal, academic, and career goals.
(We will focus on every student's strengths and opportunities to ensure growth.)**

Strategies

1. Ensure equitable access and opportunity to achieve academic excellence for every student.
2. Provide structures, alternatives and extended learning opportunities to address academic and behavioral needs.
3. Increase teacher and administrator capacity to use data to improve instruction and by implementing and monitoring appropriate interventions.
4. Recruit and retain highly qualified staff.
5. Ensure that high quality professional development and coaching related to effective assessment and instructional strategies will be provided to teachers and administrators.
6. Maximize enrollment in early childhood education.
7. Ensure accountability for fidelity to curriculum and instructional effectiveness throughout the district.

Goal 2: The Ritenour School District will ensure every student successfully graduates high school prepared for college or career. (We will engage every student in rigorous and relevant learning.)

Strategies

1. Provide supports and resources to ensure progress toward graduation.
2. Engage parents and students in college and career planning through personal plans of study.
3. Partner with post-secondary learning institutions and community organizations.

Goal 3: The Ritenour School District will ensure all students regularly attend school, meeting the standard of 90% of students attending 90% of the time.

(We will create the learning environment in which students attend and thrive.)

Strategies

1. Implement and facilitate parent education programs and communications that specifically relate to attendance.
2. Implement problem solving structures using data to improve individual student attendance and achievement.
3. Ensure that rigorous, relevant and engaging instruction occurs in safe classroom environments.
