In partnership with the St. Louis County Library and funded through the CARES Act, Miriam Learning Center is offering free, in-person and virtual tutoring with special education, reading, content, and other certified teachers!

Free tutoring is available to **St. Louis County residents** in grades PreK- college, from February 22nd through May 28th. Eligible participants should require in-person instruction or specialized virtual tutoring in order to learn, and must have a household income of less than \$80,000 for a family of 1-4 or less than \$90,000 for a family of 5 or more, to qualify for services.

Students may receive a maximum of one 50-minute tutoring session each week.
