The Ritenour Transitional Kindergarten Program serves students from Ritenour elementary schools. The program is located at Ritenour School for Early Childhood Education and is designed for students who are age-appropriate for kindergarten but not quite ready for the expectations of a larger classroom environment.

Education isn't just about developing a child's intellectual capabilities; there are emotional, social, physical, and many other factors that come into play. The program gives students the support they need by providing smaller class sizes and individualized attention.

## Eligibility

The program is designed for children who are kindergarten age and may not be academically or socially ready for a larger kindergarten class. This also includes students who may not have age appropriate self-control, may not separate from caregivers easily or may simply benefit from more time to mature. Up to 12 students will be accepted into the program at a time.
